




Mission Letter

The year 2025 has been a special and significant year for the *Society of Missionaries of Africa* as we celebrated two hundred years of the birth of **Charles Martial Cardinal Lavigerie**, born on 31 October 1825. It has been a time to give thanks for the gift of this man, founder of both the *Society of Missionaries of Africa* (1868) and the *Missionary Sisters of Our Lady of Africa* (1869), to the Church and to Africa.

More than anything else, he was a man of vision, a man of hope and a man of Faith, who fought against the injustices of his time, especially the slave trade. He was not afraid to speak his mind in the presence of people of power. He was a *Prophetic Witness* in his day, and he invites each member of his family to be a prophetic witness today. It is in this mission that each of you, as friends of our Society, shares.

The year 2025 has also been a special year in the Universal Church as we celebrated the Jubilee Year with the theme *Pilgrims of Hope*. In October, the theme of Mission Sunday 2025, *Missionaries of Hope for All Peoples*, further emphasized this call.
